- Provides appropriate case management, including work with ECDSS, schools, probation, PCP and other agencies  
Assists clients with linkages to appropriate community resources to enhance treatment and recovery.
- Communicates with others in client services system to coordinate care. Such contacts may include, but not be limited to, primary care physicians, members of the multi-disciplinary team, insurance companies and service providers involved in the care of clients.
